Who We Are: Four Degrees Apart is a harp and percussion duo currently based out of San Diego and Nashville respectively. We are a group that tries to bend and play with the line between EDM and new music. Comprised of Candace LiVolsi, a harpist who has played everywhere from Burning Man to Carnegie Hall, and Eric Whitmer, a percussionist who has a passion for performing new music in new ways, Four Degrees Apart is a new duo of experienced players looking to create a new breadth of repertoire.

What We Are Looking For:

Some guidelines about our instrumentation: We are looking for an electronic (tape) or live electronics that can be organized with the human performers via click track. Percussion instruments should be limited to a 5.0 Octave Marimba. If there are one or two small other instruments (i.e. triangle, woodblocks, metal pipes, kick drum) please be in contact with us!

What We Will Do: Get to know you better! We love working with composers and we will help workshop your proposal! We know that harp and percussion can be difficult to write for and we look forward to the opportunity to help give you a performer's insight to our instruments. Selected works and artists will receive a recording of their work performed by 4°A. High quality audio and video will be provided for the composer's portfolio.
